I do edge-to edge long-arm quilting at my home in East Falmouth. I charge 2 cents per square inch and take 2 quilts at a time so that I can turn around your quilt in 2 weeks or less. I can provide Hobbs poly-down batting or you can provide the batting of your choice.

I have a Nolting long-arm 24". It is hand guided (no computer).  
I have been doing quilts for about 10 years. I currently do only edge to edge quilting with pantographs and charge 2 cents per square inch (width x length = total square inches x 0.02)  
There is a \$5.00 charge for needle and thread on all quilts; there is a charge of 15 cents per running inch for attaching binding and 25 cents for attached and hand sewn binding. Customers may purchase Dream Cotton Select for quilts at \$20.00 per yard.
