

Walker Pouch

Pattern provided by Jackie Walsh

½ yd. quilted fabric

½ yd. cotton fabric to match

Snaps or Velcro

Thread

Cardboard for bottom (optional)

On your quilted fabric, cut off a 7" x 13" piece for the outside pocket – you can cut of more or less to make it as deep as you want. Make the pocket with lining and stitch to the front of quilt piece you are using. Stitch up sides. Do the same on the lining. You may make a pocket for the inside of the purse also.

When you have done this, cut pieces of quilted fabric 4-5" by 7" to form tabs also from original piece you cut off (these are for tabs for hanging pouch to walker. Use Velcro or snaps on one end of tabs and the other mate on the pouch. When this is done and ready to put lining and quilted fabric together, press seam allowance on top of both pouch and lining put lining inside of pouch with right sides looking at you. Pin together with two tabs inside on top so they will be sewn with the seam.
