Tips & Tricks



In the May/June issue of Quiltmaker Magazine there is an article on maintaining your sewing machine, Sew Well Maintained by Melody Munson. It goes over cleaning, oiling, changing needles and troubleshooting.

On cleaning she recommends a drop of oil on Q tips to clean around the bobbin and thread take up area. I use pipe cleaners to clean around those areas. I don't need oil to attract the fuzz and threads to the pipecleaner. If I clean after each bobbin change, it helps things to go smoothly. 
